Expected prices for 2025 are low for many crops. Enroll in commodity support programs now. If markets change, you can change your elections before the April 15<sup>th</sup> deadline. USDA updates 2025 farm price projections in mid-February and market/policy uncertainties may become clearer. I will update my recommendations as the sign-up deadline approaches.

## Summary of recommendations for Wisconsin farmers for the 2025 crop year:

- 1. Corn, Sunflower Seeds, Sorghum: <u>Signup for PLC</u> to maximize expected payments
- 2. Soybeans, Oats, Wheat, Barley: <u>Signup for County ARC</u> (ARC-CO), but if you want to buy SCO (Supplemental Coverage Option) crop insurance, <u>then signup for PLC</u>
